OFFICIAL SCHOOL UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS
Girls

GENERAL UNIFORM GUIDELINES

- Shirts and blouses will remain tucked in at all times.
- Belts must be worn when belt loops are present and conservative in style.
- All clothing needs to fit appropriately. Not too tight or too loose.
- Girls' slacks must be fitted properly (i.e. not too tight). They are to have no frays or holes.
- When weather dictates, only school approved outerwear is allowed inside school buildings.
- No hats, caps, or sweatshirt hoods may be worn during the regular school day.
- No extreme hair dyes or hair styles. Appropriateness to be determined by administration.
- Jewelry: Conservative in style and size. Multiple ear piercing is prohibited as is any other body piercing.
- Tee shirts (undershirts) worn by students must be solid colors of white, grey, navy, or black. No printed undershirts are permitted.
- P.E. Uniforms are purchased through the uniform stores
- Chapel attire is required on Wednesday of each week.
- Spiritwear shirts, purchased from the school, may be worn on each Friday with uniform approved pants, skorts, etc..

GIRLS (K-5th GRADES)

All clothing must be purchased from a uniform store.

****The only exceptions are the items marked with an asterisk. ****

BLOUSES	White (short/long sleeve) Peter Pan Blouse (to wear with navy or plaid jumper).
SHIRTS	New! Royal Blue, White, Red, Light Blue (last year for this color is 2012-2013, phasing out) , Navy, Hunter Green, and Black Polo Shirt (short/long sleeve, regular or girls' fitted polo) w/school logo Logo may be heat-pressed or embroidered on polo shirts. <u>(Navy Polo w/logo is required for chapel, unless wearing the approved navy jumper).</u> White or Blue Oxford Shirt (short/long sleeve) with MPCS logo. White, Navy, Hunter Green Turtlenecks to be worn under jumpers (no logo required), not to be worn independently.
JUMPERS	Navy Jumper Style #156 with White Peter Pan Blouse listed above. Plaid Jumper with white Peter Pan or Turtleneck (Plaid #60, style #194) (no shorter than 2" above the knee, and <u>must be worn with bike shorts</u>) Jumpers are not required to have a logo. Navy Jumper Permitted for Chapel. (K-5th only)
SKIRTS	Khaki or Navy Pleated Skirt Style #143, (no shorter than 2" above the knee, and <u>must be worn with bike shorts</u>). Khaki Skirt Permitted for Chapel.
SKORTS	Khaki, Plaid, or Navy Wrap, Tab or Full Wrap Skort, (no shorter than 2" above the knee) Khaki Skort Permitted for Chapel (K-5th only)
SHORTS	Khaki or Navy Uniform Shorts (Pleated or Flat Front). Khaki Shorts Permitted for Chapel (K-5th only)

CAPRIS Khaki or Navy Capri Pants Style #2549 or #5155 Only.
Khaki or Navy Cargo Capri Pants Universal Style #626
Khaki Capri Pants Permitted for Chapel. (K-5th only)

DRESS Navy Knit shirt dress, not allowed for chapel days (K-2nd only allowed to wear this dress)

SLACKS Khaki or Navy Uniform Slacks (Pleated or Flat Front),
style # 7113, #7115, or #7427.
Khaki or Navy Uniform Low Rise Flare Pants Style #2548 or #4049 Only
Khaki Pants Permitted for Chapel.

The following is a list of the only approved non-uniform store slacks. They will not need the MPCS initials logo, but must be on the approved list in order to be worn. Not all pants from these stores are acceptable.

If you are unsure it meets the criteria, please check with the administration.

*Belk, American Eagle, GAP, Navy, Land's End, As Chino/Classic Fit - Khaki or Navy,

Traditional Pleated or Flat Front - Khaki or Navy

*French Toast: Traditional Pleated or Flat Front - Khaki or Navy

NO "STONE" COLOR or NON-UNIFORM LOW RISE FLARE WILL BE ACCEPTABLE. TRADITIONAL KHAKI ONLY. If you are unsure it meets the criteria, please check with the administration.

OUTERWEAR Navy or Black Cardigan, Pullover, or Sweater Vest with MPCS embroidered monogram.
Navy or Black Fleece Lined Windbreaker (Embroidered Logo Optional)
Navy or Black Fleece Jacket (half or full zip) (Embroidered Logo Optional)
Navy or Black Fleece Vest (embroidered logo)
Navy or Black Sweatshirt with MPCS logo or MPCS embroidered monogram
Outerwear may have the students' name embroidered on the right chest in block or script letters

Outerwear approved by an organization from within the school (e.g. athletics, band, booster clubs, color guard, cheerleaders, etc.) may be worn. These must be in the school colors of blue, black, gray, or white to be approved for wearing during the school day.

BELTS Conservative in Style and Color, no studs or large buckles
Khaki or Navy stretch fabric belt or magnetic belt
Brown or Black solid leather belt, smooth or braided

HAIR School uniform colors used for Headband, Scrunchie, Barrette, or Bow,
ACCESSORIES No feathers or distracting accessories

SOCKS/ TIGHTS White, Navy, Hunter Green, Khaki, or Red Crew Socks or Knee Highs (cable, flat, or opaque)
White or Navy Opaque Tights or White Sport Socks

SHOES Conservative school-type shoes in black, brown, navy (new) or tan. (No open toes, sandals, heelies, or flip flops),
Conservative (neutral colors only), non-skid sole boots may be worn from Dec. 1-March 31.
Pants must **not** be tucked into boots.
Tennis shoes predominately in school colors of White, Black, Blue, Gray (accent colors or soles must be minimal unless in school colors listed)

GIRLS (6th-12th GRADES)

All clothing must be purchased from a uniform store.

****The only exceptions are the items marked with an asterisk. ****

SHIRTS NEW! Royal Blue, White, Red, Light Blue (last year, phasing out), Navy, Hunter Green, and Black Polo Shirt (short/long sleeve, regular or girls' fitted polo) w/school logo. (Navy Polo w/logo is required for chapel). **Logo may be heat-pressed or embroidered on polo shirts.** White or Blue Oxford Shirt (short/long sleeve) with MPCS logo.

SKIRTS Khaki or Navy Long Skirt (#1526 or #2662) **Khaki Skirt Permitted for Chapel.**

SLACKS Khaki or Navy Uniform Slacks (Pleated or Flat Front)
Khaki or Navy Uniform Low Rise Flare (#2548)
Khaki Pants only are Permitted for Chapel.

The following is a list of the only approved non-uniform store slacks. They will not need the MPCS initials logo, but must be on the approved list in order to be worn. If you are in doubt if a pair of pants will be approved, ask the school to approve.

*Belk, American Eagle, GAP, Navy, Land's End, As Chino/Classic Fit - Khaki or Navy,
Traditional Pleated or Flat Front - Khaki or Navy

Other slacks guidelines:

NON-UNIFORM LOW RISE FLARE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTABLE.

TRADITIONAL KHAKI ONLY.

At the waist or just below the waist. Low waist should have 4" zipper or more.

No ULTRA low waist with 3" zipper or less.

NO "STONE" COLOR.

If you are unsure it meets the criteria, please receive approval from the administration.

CAPRIS Khaki or Navy Capri (#5155 or #2549). Girls may wear cargo capris (#626) in either khaki or navy, from the uniform store.

OUTERWEAR Navy or Black Cardigan, or Pullover with MPCS embroidered monogram.
Navy or Black Fleece Lined Windbreaker (Embroidered Logo Optional)
Navy or Black Fleece Jacket (half or full zip) (Embroidered Logo Optional)
Navy or Black Fleece Vest (embroidered logo optional)
Navy or Black Sweatshirt with MPCS logo or MPCS embroidered monogram
Outerwear may have the students' name embroidered on the right chest in block or script letters.
Solid colors of gray, white, black or navy outerwear are acceptable. No large logos, other than MPCS school logos.
Administration has discretion to determine appropriateness.
Outerwear which is approved by an organization from within the school (e.g. athletics, band, booster clubs, color guard, cheerleaders, etc.) may be worn during the school day.

BELTS & SOCKS Conservative in Style and Color, Belts not to have studs or large belt buckles

HAIR ACCESSORIES School uniform colors used for Headband, Scrunchie, Barrette, or Bow. No feathers or distracting accessories

SHOES Conservative school-type shoes in black, brown, navy or tan. (No open toes, sandals, heeries, or flip flops) or Middle School: Conservative (neutral colors only), non-skid sole boots may be worn.
Flats or loafer style shoes in neutral colors and conservative in style
Pants must not be tucked into boots for Middle School girls.
Tennis shoes in School colors of White, Black, Blue, Gray
High School: Conservative (neutral colors only), non-skid sole boots may be worn.
Flats or loafer style shoes in neutral colors and conservative in style
Tennis shoes in School colors of White, Black, Blue, Gray (accent colors or soles must be minimal unless in school colors listed)
Slides, Birkenstocks, flats in conservative style and color approved for **High School only**

P.E. UNIFORM MS must wear PE uniforms. HS will receive instruction from P.E. teacher.

Ash Gray MPCS Short or long sleeve P.E. T-shirt & Navy Mesh Shorts with P.E. Logo or Navy sweat pants, from uniform store.

Boys

GENERAL UNIFORM GUIDELINES

- Shirts will remain tucked in at all times.
- Belts must be worn when belt loops are present.
- All clothing needs to fit appropriately. Not too tight or too loose. No holes or frays.
- Boys' trousers must be worn properly (not too low so as to bunch excessively at the ankles).
- When weather dictates, only school approved outerwear is allowed inside school buildings.
- No hats, caps, or sweatshirt hoods may be worn during the regular school day.
- No extreme hair dyes or hair styles. Boys' hair must be above the eyebrows and off the collar. Appropriateness to be determined by administration. More details in student handbook.
- Male ear piercing or any other body piercing is prohibited.
- Tee shirts (undershirts) worn by students must be solid colors of white, grey, navy, or black. No printed undershirts are permitted.
- P.E. Uniforms are purchased through the uniform stores
- Chapel attire is required on Wednesday of each week.
- Spiritwear shirts, purchased from the school, may be worn on each Friday with uniform approved pants, skorts, etc..

BOYS (K-12TH GRADES)

All clothing must be purchased from a uniform store.

****The only exceptions are the items marked with an asterisk. ****

SHIRTS NEW! Royal Blue, White, Red, Lt. Blue(last year, phasing out), Navy, Hunter Green, and Black Polo Shirt (short/long sleeve) w/school logo.

Logo may be heat pressed or embroidered on polo shirts.

White or Blue Oxford Shirt (short/long sleeve) with MPCS logo.

(Navy Polo w/logo is required for chapel.)

K-5th White or black turtlenecks may be worn under uniform shirts.

SHORTS Khaki or Navy Uniform Shorts (Pleated or Flat Front)
Khaki or Navy Cargo Shorts

Khaki Color Shorts allowed for Chapel K-5th grades only, pants only for 6-12!

Conservative in style, traditional in color

SLACKS Khaki or Navy Uniform Cargo Pants
Khaki or Navy Uniform Slacks (Pleated or Flat Front)
Conservative in style, traditional in color

Khaki Pants (no shorts) Required for Chapel (6th-12th Grades).

K-5th boys may wear pants or shorts for Chapel.

The following is a list of the only approved non-uniform store slacks. They will not need the MPCS initials logo, but must be on the approved list to be worn. **If you are in doubt, please seek approval of pants from the school administration. Model #'s may change from year to year.**

***Land's End:** Chino/Classic Fit – Khaki or Navy

*Gap: Slim Fit Flat Front Clean Khaki's in "Khaki" color only

*Old Navy: Plain or Pleated Super Khaki's in "brown kelp" or "navy blue" color

*French Toast: Traditional Pleated or Flat Front – Khaki or Navy (**K-5th Grades Only**)

*American Eagle Outfitter: Classic Khakis – Traditional Khaki Color Only (**6th-12th Grades**)

NO "STONE" COLOR WILL BE ACCEPTABLE. TRADITIONAL KHAKI ONLY.

OUTERWEAR Navy or Black Cardigan, Pullover, or Sweater Vest with MPCS embroidered monogram.
Navy or Black Fleece Lined Windbreaker (Embroidered Logo Optional)
Navy or Black Fleece Jacket (half or full zip) (Embroidered Logo Optional)
Navy or Black Fleece Vest (embroidered logo optional)
Navy or Black Sweatshirt with MPCS logo or MPCS embroidered monogram

Solid colors of gray, white, black or navy outerwear are acceptable. No large logos, other than MPCS school logos. Administration has discretion to determine appropriateness.

Outerwear which is approved by an organization from within the school (e.g. athletics, band, booster clubs, color guard, cheerleaders, etc.) may be worn during the school day.

SOCKS Conservative in style and color

BELTS Conservative in Style and Color, no studs or large buckles.
Khaki or Navy stretch fabric belt or magnetic belt
Brown or Black solid leather belt, smooth or braided

SHOES Conservative school-type shoes in black, brown, navy (K-5th only) or tan.
(No open toes, sandals, heeies, or flip flops)
Tennis shoes in school colors of White, Black, Blue, Gray (accent colors or soles must be minimal unless in school colors listed).

P.E. UNIFORMS (6TH-12TH Grades)

MS must wear PE uniforms. HS will receive instruction from P.E. teacher.

Ash Gray MPCS P.E. T-shirt (Short or long sleeve)

Navy Mesh Shorts with P.E. Logo, Navy sweat pants purchased from the uniform store
